

SCHOLAR APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE ERASMUS MUNDUS MASTER IN WOMEN'S AND GENDER STUDIES (GEMMA):

IMPORTANT: Please, read all the admission criteria before applying.

Application information

Scholars should be in possession of at least a University Bachelor degree (or its equivalent: 180 ECTS, minimum 3 years of study)

Scholars should have proven knowledge of the language of instruction of the GEMMA Host Institution

Scholars should complete application form in all sections (applications can be completed in English or in any of the other two teaching languages: Italian and Spanish).

The following documents should be attached to the application:

1. Motivation letter
2. Official copy of the scholar's previous academic record and diplomas (the candidate must provide a translation into any of the GEMMA working languages)
3. A photocopy of the candidate's passport
4. Two letters of recommendation
5. Certificates proving sufficient knowledge of the language of instruction of the host institution (English TOEFL or Cambridge Proficiency test or equivalent; Spanish Instituto Cervantes DELE certificate or equivalent; Italian Dante Institute standard test or equivalent)
6. For each publication a photocopy of the index (in case of a book), the first page of the book/article/chapter, and a photocopy of the copyright must be provided

Note: If you are selected for the programme you may be requested additional documents.

Submission of applications

Deadline for applications is **January 10th**, Granada local time. All applications received after that date will not be considered.

All the documents accompanying the application must be received at the GEMMA Central Office in Granada before **January 20th**. Documents received after that date will not be considered.

The application form should ideally be submitted on-line. If this was not possible, due to technical difficulties, candidates may fax the application to the GEMMA Central Office (fax number: +34 958 243 009) before the deadline.

A hard copy of the complete application, including copies of original documents and official transcripts of academic records, must be posted to the GEMMA Central Office. Documents should be posted by express mail so that they are received at the GEMMA Central Office by January 20th at the latest. Only in exceptional cases we may accept the documents by fax.

- b. Prior relevant knowledge/experience (15%)
- c. Proven knowledge of one of the languages (5%)
- d. Motivation (20%)
- e. Social skills and competences (5%)
- f. Other (5%)
