Requirements	A. Registered student at TAU B. Minimum average of 80 C. Fluent English – the minimum required level is B1 D. Chemistry students are also required to have a minimum level of B1 in the German language. E. Students from the following fields: Chemistry; Electricity and Energy; Electronic and Automation; Biology; Computer Science; Mathematics; Physics; Environmental Sciences, Ecology; Engineering, Business and Administration, Mechanics and Metal Work, Medical Diagnostic and treatment technology (Medical Technology and Engineering, offered by the Department of Mechanical Engineering). Number of required credits for	Students are required to take at least 30 ECTS credits (equivalent to 15 TAU credits) in order to be eligible for the Erasmus Plus Scholarship.
