

Call for applications: Erasmus Plus scholarships to study at Alexandru Ioan Cuza University of Iasi (UAIC) during the spring semester of 2017-18 academic year

The European Union is offering **3** scholarships for students from all degree levels (Bachelor's Master's and PhD) to study at Alexandru Ioan Cuza University of Iasi within the Erasmus Plus Program. Detailed information is available in the table below.

Requirements	<p>A. Registered student at TAU</p> <p>B. Minimum average of 80</p> <p>C. Fluent English – the minimum required level is B1. (UAIC accepts an English proficiency test completed at TAU's Division of Foreign Languages)</p> <p>D. Bachelor's and master's student can only participate in the program from the 1st semester of the second year of studies until the 1st semester of the last year of studies.</p> <p>E. PhD students can arrive to UAIC for a shorter period than 6 months (the minimum period is 3 months). Since PhD students do not have to take courses, they can also arrive to UAIC in order to conduct research, pending receiving an invitation from a supervisor at UAIC. In any case, students must complete their exchange period by July 31st 2018.</p>

Number of required credits for bachelor's and master's students	<p>Students are required to take at least 30 ECTS credits (equivalent to 15 TAU credits) in order to be eligible for the Erasmus Plus Scholarship.</p> <p>* Deviations may be possible, pending approval from UAIC University</p>
Requirements from PhD students	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • PhD students are not required to take any classes. • PhD students are required to submit an invitation letter from a faculty member at UAIC University.

It needs to include all the classes that you plan to take at UAIC and the number of credits earned in each class. It needs to be completed and signed by the academic advisor at TAU and by the coordinator of the office of international academic affairs at UAIC prior to the mobility.</p>

Required insurance	<p>Medical Insurance: Students are required to purchase medical insurance suitable to their medical needs for the whole duration of stay at UAIC, including travel.</p> <p>Liability Insurance: Students are required to purchase liability insurance for the whole duration of stay at UAIC, including travel.</p> <p>It is under the student responsibility to insure himself/herself for the whole duration of stay</p> <p>Students are required to submit a proof of insurance to the office of international academic affairs at TAU prior to their mobility period.</p>
Deadline	<p>Application Deadline to TAU: July 13, 2017</p> <p>Interviews will take place between July 16 to July 21, 2017 (exact day will follow)</p>
