Call for Pilot Research Proposals

January 2013

Starting in 2013 EHF will fund multi-disciplinary pilot grants to support environmental health research.

<u>Purpose:</u> The purpose of these one-year nonrenewable grants is to assist Israeli scientists in the area of Environment and Health in obtaining preliminary data to serve as the basis for strengthening a future innovative proposal for a larger grant application to other public or private agencies offering major research grants in this field, such as the European Union, the NIEHS, and the like. <u>Award Amount:</u> Up to \$40,000.

Proposals should be written in English, (excluding the cover page) and should be uploaded to the EHF documents server: http://depot.ehf.org.il/pilotproposals

Layout Format: English, line spacing of 1.5, font equivalent of 12, margins ~ 2.5 cm all around.

Proposals should follow the guidelines found in the document "Guidelines for Applicants 2013". "Guidelines for Applicants 2013" can be found on the EHF website: www.ehf.org.il, under Research Grants or מענקי מחקר

It is essential to read these guidelines *before* submitting the pilot research proposal.

Pilot proposals must be uploaded to the EHF server not later than March 17, 2013.

EHF acknowledges receipt of proposals. If the PI does not receive an acknowledgement then the proposal was not received and the PI should contact EHF directly.
