A final minimum B.A. or B.Ed. grade of 83 in the following program:

A final minimum B.A. or B.Ed. grade of 80 in the following programs:

- Curriculum Planning – including Educational Communication and Technology
- Measurement and Evaluation (For graduates of Exact Science and Life Science, a final minimum B.A. grade of 75 is needed)
- Language Education – English
- Language Education – Arabic
- History and Philosophy of Education

A final minimum B.A. or B.Ed. grade of 75 in the following programs:

- Science Education
- All Specializations excluding Technology and Learning

Applicants for M.A. studies in the programs Language Teaching, History Teaching and Science Education must have a teaching certificate. Those who have not will be required to obtain a teaching certificate.

Admission depends on the Admissions Committee's decisions.

Teaching Certificate Studies

This is a one or two year program, depending on the candidates track and previous academic studies.

Only university graduates can apply for Teaching Certificate studies.
