Language	It is possible to participate in the Master Programme in <b>English</b> entirely, as English is the main language of instruction and examination.
	Some parts of the programme may additionally be offered in <b>German</b> , depending on the language skills and interests of the applicants.

## **Admission requirements**

• A university degree with a grade above average, preferably in law, in economics or in political science representing a total of 240 credit points (CP) according to the European Transfer and Accumulation System (ECTS).

Applicants who have earned their first degree qualifying for a professional career representing a total of 180 CP must compensate for the missing 60 CP by a good performance in additional or practical training programmes in fields similar to those of the Master Programme.

- Very good English language proficiency.
- Very good German language proficiencies are required in case the student wishes to also attend German lectures and sit examinations in German.

**Aim** of the Master Programme is the interdisciplinary and applied education of a select number of highly qualified graduates from all over the world are provided with in-depth knowledge about the legal, economic and political aspects of the process of European integration.

The **curriculum** consists of a basic programme covering the foundations of the European Union as a legal, economic and political community, as well as an elective specialisation programme allowing students to concentrate on one of the four areas: "The EU as a Political Actor", "External Relations of the EU", "Companies as Economic Actors" as well as "Law of the EU". The range of specialisation fields may vary from academic year to academic year due to the interests of the applicants.

Due to the "**College Model**" students have the opportunity to combine studying and living under one roof.
