## World's biggest drug haul Heroin worth over \$100m. seized by Marseilles police

ABUS (AP). — French customs agents seized 425 kgs, of pure seroin shoard a shrimp boat yesterday. The French Finance Ministry alled it the biggest haul in history and the Paris office of the U.S. Sarcotics Bureau said this amount would be enough for a one-zonth supply for every American addict.
