

The jobs will pay an average of about \$27,000 per year not including benefits, which is lower than the county's average wage. The relatively lower pay was the reason for the smaller incentive package from the county, officials said.

The new location will be a consolidation of several billing centers around the country. LabCorp considered locations from Charlotte to Danville before deciding on Greensboro. Among the factors the company considered were proximity to the headquarters in Burlington, the availability of a qualified work force and training assistance from Guilford Technical Community College, said Brad Morton, LabCorp's senior vice president of billing operations.
