Transportation to Tel Aviv

- 1. Taxi from the airport to Tel aviv. Approx. 150-180 NIS.
- 2. Train and taxi/bus

From the airport, take the train to Tel Aviv HaShalom (Azrieli) station. Then take a taxi to your hotel.

Buses

The campus is served by numerous bus routes, listed below according to the two main bus companies, Egged and Dan.

Egged routes: 74, 86, 270, 271, 274, 572, 604.

Dan routes: 6, 7, 13, 24, 25, 45, 49, 127, 220, 89, 189, 289.

There is also a public taxi <u>4a</u> ("Sheroot") – yellow minibuses from Allenby and Ben Yehuda streets.

Trains

The University Railway Station is within walking distance from campus (on its southeast flank), or you can catch Dan routes 7, 45 and 127 to the station.

Taxi

Arriving by taxi from Tel Aviv is easy — either catch one in the street (white cars, with a yellow hat), or install a taxi app called "Gett". Make sure the driver uses the meter (which in Hebrew is "Mone", pronounced like the French painter with the water lilies).

Taxies stars from 12.80 NIS and arriving from center Tel Aviv may cost between 35 and 50 NIS.

Parking

Parking inside the TAU campus is permitted only for teaching and administrative staff.

Students and visitors arriving with a car are encouraged to use one of the many parking lots adjacent to the campus, as can be seen on the Campus Map.
